The Shaker origins in the United States began outside of Albany, New York, and today the last remaining members are in Sabbathday Lake, Maine. Through the interweaving of the history of this fascinating Protestant Utopian sect with modern day photography, we'll learn about the development and influence of the Shakers from the late 1700s to the present. Shaker villages in Eastern New York and New England, many still in existence as museums, will be highlighted.

Bruce Magnuson, now retired from a career in financial services, avidly pursues his interests in photography, art, and history. His photography has appeared in multiple shows at the Griffin Museum of Photography, Winchester, MA, and at various other venues including solo shows at the Parish Center for the Arts, Westford, MA, the Chelmsford Library, Chelmsford, MA, and one featuring his infrared photographs at the Acton Memorial Library in Acton, MA. He has presented widely on topics ranging from international affairs, social justice, art, photography, and the history of his home region, the Hudson River Valley.
