Hamlets tended to grow up around a geographic resource or common industry like quarrying, farming, brickmaking, or another livelihood.

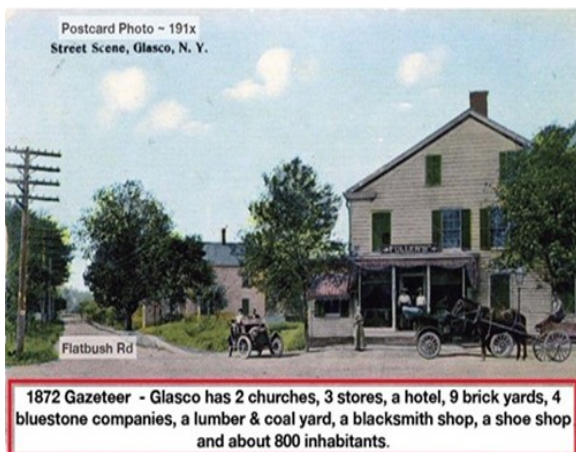
Conveniences for residents like a school, church or store often followed. Sometimes different circumstances or job opportunities caused immigrant populations to cluster in a particular hamlet so that even today, many people identify with a specific community such as Mt. Marion, Glasco, Quarryville, etc.
